

## **HEAD WOMEN'S SWIMMING COACH** **HASTINGS COLLEGE**

Hastings College seeks qualified applicants for the position of Head Women's Swimming Coach. This is a ten month, non-tenure track position.

A Bachelor's Degree is required; Master's preferred. Successful coaching, teaching and recruiting experience preferred. A general knowledge of NAIA rules will be beneficial. A commitment to the educational values of sport is expected. Depending upon degree and experience, rank within the Department of Physical Education and Human Performance is a possibility.

The Kiewit gymnasium pool will be renovated and used as a practice facility. Home meets will be held at the Hastings Family YMCA.
