- MEET FORMAT:** Timed Final, age group meet, Gold/Silver.
- DISABILITY SWIMMERS:** Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the Deck Referee of any disability prior to competition.
- RULES:** Current USA Swimming and MWS rules will apply.
- CREDENTIALS:**
- Presentation of coach's USA swimming membership card will be required at coach sign-in. Credentials shall be visible at all times.
 - In accordance with MWS Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
- ELIGIBILITY:**
- All swimmers, coaches, and clubs must be currently registered with USA Swimming. Age of swimmer on October 31, 2009 determines age for the entire meet.
 - Late entries and deck entries will require proof of USA Swimming registration.
- EVENT LIMITS:**
- Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 individual events per day.
 - Time trials will not be offered.
 - The meet will be limited to the first 450 swimmers (teams will not be split).
 - Notification will be made if entries cannot be accepted.
- ENTRY FEES:** Individual events \$3.00
Midwestern fee \$5.00 per swimmer

- ENTRY PROCEDURE:**
- Entries may be submitted either in electronic format (Hy-Tek file meet entry file with hard copy) or a Meet Entry Form.
 - A check for the total amount due must accompany the entries. **Make checks payable to LSS.**
- ENTRY DEADLINE:**
- Entries should be received by **Friday, October 23, 2009.**
 - Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director. If you desire confirmation of receipt of entries, enclose a SASE or request an e-mail receipt.

- Deck entries (with proof of USA Swimming registration) will be accepted only to fill open lanes. No new heats will be created. Deck entries will be charged **double fees and fees must be paid before entries will be finalized**. Deck entries will not be accepted for a session once that session has started.

CONDUCT OF MEET:

- All events are timed finals.
- Meet will be pre-seeded.
- The official Meet Program will indicate swimmer’s heat and lane.
- The 500 and 1650 freestyles will be deck seeded and require positive check in. Only the fastest 20 swimmers per 1650 event will be swum in the meet and these events will be swum fastest heats to slowest, alternating girls and boys heats. Swimmers in these events must provide their own timers.
- Fly over starts may be used.
- 11 & Over events will be scored as 11-12 and 13 & Over.

WARM-UP PROCEDURE:

- MWS Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, or club for the failure to follow the safety rules.
- Teams may be assigned lanes for warm-ups. MWS Safety Guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect. The first 40 minutes of each session will be general warm-up. The last 20 minutes will be open for starts when your lane is ready. The diving well will be available for warming up and warming down during the meet.

TEAM SUPERVISION:

- Each team must provide an adult with non-athlete USA swimming card to supervise the team in the team area at all times.
- **Only registered coaches, swimmers, meet volunteers, and meet officials will be allowed on deck.**

SCORING: Meet will not be scored. Swimmers will be placed in Gold/Silver categories based on entry time..

AWARDS:

- Ribbons (Gold and Silver levels) 1st-10th place for 8 & U, 9 – 10, 11 – 12 age groups
- Heat winner awards
- Awards to coaches at the conclusion of the meet.

FINAL RESULTS:

- Meet results will be available on disk at the end of the meet – bring your own media.
- Results will also be available via e-mail of a Hy-Tek TM results file if request is made at the computer table at the conclusion of the meet.

TIMERS AND JUDGES:

- Each participating club will be requested to provide 2 volunteer timers during various sessions of the meet.
- Teams are welcome and encouraged to volunteer certified stroke and turn judges. Interested teams should contact the Meet Director to make arrangements.

- Coaches’ packets will be available.
- Action Accents will be at the meet selling swim apparel.
