- POOL:**
- 25 yards, 8 lanes, Daktronics 2000 Timing System with touch pads and scoreboard, anti-turbulent lane lines. The water depth of the competition pool measured for a distance of 3' 3 1/2" (1.0 meter) to 16' 5" (5.0 meters) from the start wall is 3.5ft to 4ft and the water depth at the end or turn wall when measured for a distance of 3' 3 1/2" (1.0 meter) to 16' 5" (5.0 meters) is 13ft – 12ft (USA-S Rule 202.3.4.D).
 - Pool has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
- FACILITY:**
- HLA reserves the right to remove any individual from the premises who might jeopardize safety and facility privileges.
 - Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the blocks, in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.

- RULES:** Current USA Swimming and Midwestern Rules will apply.

- MEET FORMAT:** 11-12 Pentathlon: Timed finals, No Time Standards. Events placed by age & gender.
10 & Under: Timed Finals; No Time Standards. Events placed by age.
- DISABILITY SWIMMERS:** Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete or athlete's coach is also responsible for notifying the Deck referee of any disability prior to competition.
- CREDENTIALS:**
- Presentation of coach's membership credentials will be required at coach sign-in. Credentials shall be available at all times.
 - In accordance with MWS Policy, only those coaches with current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
- ELIGIBILITY:**
- All swimmers, coaches, and clubs must be currently registered with USA Swimming.
 - Age of swimmer on September 27, 2015, determines age for the entire meet.
 - Late entries and deck entries will require proof of USA Swimming registration.
 - Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- EVENT LIMITS:**
- Swimmers 10 & U may enter a maximum of 5 individual events and 1 relay per session
 - Swimmers 11-12 may enter a maximum of 5 individual events
 - **Host reserves right to remove relays to adhere to the 4 hour rule.**
 - Time trials will not be allowed. Exhibition swimming will be allowed.
- EVENT FEES:** \$2.50 per individual event, \$5.00 for relay event
\$6.00 per swimmer Midwestern splash fee; \$3.00 per swimmer facility charge – total \$9.00
Make checks payable to Heartland Aquatics. NO REFUNDS.
- ENTRY PROCEDURE:**
- Entries submitted in electronic format (Hy-Tek meet entry file with hard copy) only.
 - It is the responsibility of the submitting team to verify receipt of entries with the entry chair.

- Swimmers must be listed on the official roster and pay splash fee to be eligible for relays.
- A check for the total amount due must accompany the entries.
- The 4-hour rule will be applied. The host will accept no further entries for a session with 12 & U swimmers where the 4-hour projected time limit is reached (205.3.1F). The Meet Director reserves the right to limit events, heats, teams, and swimmers to conform to the 4-hour time limit. Teams will be notified of any and all adjustments.

ENTRY PERIOD: Entries accepted starting Monday, 09/07/2015 at 8AM through 9PM Thursday, 09/17/2015

- Psych sheets will be sent to the club entry chair within 24 hours of the entry deadline.
- Teams will have 48 hours to submit any changes.

CONDUCT OF MEET:

- All events are timed finals.
- Meet will be pre-seeded. The official Meet Program will indicate swimmer's heat and lane.
- Swimmers of all ages will be seeded together based on entry times.
- Flyover starts may be used.
- In-water breaks will be inserted as timeline allows.
- Deck entries will be accepted by the Meet Director only if there are empty lanes in pre-seeded heats, and will be charged **double fees**. Late/Deck entries will require proof of USA Swimming registration.
- Swimmers will be required to report promptly to their assigned lane prior to the start of each race in which he or she is entered.

WARM-UP PROCEDURE:

- MWS Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, or club for the failure to follow the safety rules.
- No diving during warm-ups. All 8 lanes will be open, warm-ups will be split and teams will be notified of their start times prior to the meet. "Sit & slide" entry will be in effect.

TEAM SUPERVISION:

- Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited. Midwestern penalties will apply (MWS Policies and Procedures 8.5.14).
- Each team must provide a responsible adult with non-athlete USA Swimming membership to supervise the team at all times.
- Only registered coaches, swimmers, officials and volunteers will be allowed on deck.

SCORING:

- Meet will not have team scoring.
- Placing in individual events will be by 8&U, 9-10, 11, 12 categories.

AWARDS:

- High Point will be awarded for top 3, girls & boys 11 and 12 age groups individually.
- High Point will be scored by lowest total cumulative time across all events.
- 11-12 swimmers must complete all 5 events successfully to qualify for High Point Award.
- Mystery Heats for 8U, 10&U: Random heats will be selected, winner will receive a prize.
- Meet mementos will be given to all swimmers.

AWARDS

- **Every personal best time in a non-technical suit will earn a raffle ticket.**
- **Swimmers who achieve a new personal best time and AAA time standard in any event in a non-technical suit will receive a \$5 Elmore Aquatic gift card.**
- **Swimmers who achieve a new personal best time and an LSC record in any event in a non-technical suit will receive a \$25 Elmore Aquatic gift card.**
- **Gift Cards will be emailed to winners after the meet.**

FINAL RESULTS:

Meet results will be posted on Meet Mobile. Meet Results will be posted on the Midwestern website – www.mwswim.org – within 48 hours of the meet conclusion.

CONCESSIONS:

- Meet Programs will be available. No food or beverages allowed in the pool area.
