Pool:

- The water depth of the competition pool when measured for a distance of 1 meter to 3 meters from the start wall is 12ft to 12ft 6in and the water depth at the turn end when measured for a distance of 1 meter to 3 meters is 4ft to 4ft 5in.
- Indoor 6 lane pool with warm down area. Daktronics timing system with touchpads, 6-lane scoreboard
- Short Course Yards, indoor, 6 lanes, Competitor lane lines including lane ropes outside of Lanes 1 and 6
- The host will ensure the required course dimensions.

FACILITY:

- Athletes may be on deck; no specified area.
- Admission fee for spectators \$5.00 per person includes program. Children under 5 free.
- Bleachers will be available for spectators.
- Food and drink are permitted, but glass containers are prohibited.
- Sarpy County Swim Club Coaches are all trained by the Red Cross in either lifeguarding or water safety. They
 are also trained in CPR/AED and basic first aid. The facility has access to an AED, backboards, and lifeguard
 tubes. Sarpy County Swim Club does not off athletic trainers or rehab facilities.
- Disinfecting stations sanitizer and wipes will be available
- Sarpy County Swim Club and Papillion-La Vista High School reserve the right to remove from the premises any individual who might jeopardize safety and facility privileges.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the blocks, in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- Gender neutral/family facilities are not available at this facility since it was built before current codes apply.

SWIMMERS:

CREDENTIALS: • Presentation

- Presentation of coach's membership credentials will be required at coach sign-in. Credentials shall be available at all times. The USA Swimming App is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.
- In accordance with MWS Policy, only those coaches who hold current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

ELIGIBILITY:

- All swimmers, coaches and clubs must be currently registered with USA Swimming.
- Athletes must be either year-round or seasonal athletes. (Flex members are not eligible for Championship meets)
- NO on deck registration permitted. NO late entries permitted.
- Athletes who appear as unregistered on the first pre-meet recon must register with USA Swimming immediately. A
 second pre-meet recon will be run 4 days prior to the start of the meet and any unregistered MW athlete that
 appears on that list must register with USA Swimming. The entering club will be billed \$30.00 late fee and must
 provide proof of registration before athlete is allowed to swim in the meet. Meet management must delete
 unregistered athletes from the meet file prior to meet commencement.
- The age of the swimmer on **7/21/25** determines his/her age for the entire meet.
- 8 & Under athletes only
- No Time Standards
- Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by
 a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from
 within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure
 compliance with this requirement."

ENTRY LIMITS:

- A swimmer may participate in five (5) individual events and two (2) Relays
- Relays: A, B, C, D
- No time trials.
- The 4-hour rule will be applied. The host will accept no further entries for a session with 12 & Under swimmers where a 4-hour projected time limit is reached. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit events, heats, teams, and swimmers to conform to the 4-hour time limit (205.3.1F). Teams will be notified of any and all necessary adjustments.

GENERAL MEET

- All timed final events swum Slowest to Fastest.
- Fly over starts may be used at the discretion of the meet referee and meet director.
- Each swimmer shall report promptly to his/her assigned lane prior to the start of each race in which he/she is
 entered and stand on tape provided behind the blocks when waiting for their heat to be called to help with
 social distancing behind the blocks.
- Exhibition swimming will not be allowed.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES:
